**TŁICHQ ASSEMBLY AND CHIEF'S EXECUTIVE COUNCIL  
AMENDMENT LAW 2013**

**Title**

1. This law shall be cited as the *Tłichq Assembly and Chief's Executive Council Amendment Law 2013*.

**Amendment**

2. The *Tłichq Assembly and Chief's Executive Council Law* is amended in a manner and to the extent set out in sections 3 through 7 below.
3. The following definition is added to section 2:

“Departmental Establishment Policy” means a policy that creates a department of the Tłichq Government, setting out:

- a) The Statement of Policy;
  - b) The Mandate;
  - c) Principles;
  - d) Scope;
  - e) Authority and Accountability;
  - f) Provisions;
  - g) Appointments, including establishing officers and directors; and
  - h) Prerogatives of the Chief's Executive Council.
4. The following is added after section 6:

**Departmental Establishment Policy**

6.1 The Chief's Executive Council shall establish Departmental Establishment Policies for the following subject matters:

- a) Finance and financial administration;
- b) Language, culture and communications;
- c) Human resources;
- d) Executive support and services;
- e) Lands protection, administration and land use planning;
- f) Programs and services, including community services and social programs; and
- g) Such other subject matters as determined by the Chief's Executive Council.

For greater certainty, the Chief's Executive Council may establish new departments or single departments covering multiple subject matters as part of the internal management of Tł̓ch̓q Government departments.

### **Language, Culture and Communication**

6.2 The Chief's Executive Council shall direct the administration and carrying out of the language, culture and communications programs of the Tł̓ch̓q Government which shall include:

- (a) ensuring the language and culture programs and activities of the Tł̓ch̓q Government are carried out in a manner that enhances the Tł̓ch̓q language, culture and way of life;
- (b) evaluating the language and culture programs including the role of the Cultural Coordinator; and
- (c) ensuring the performance of other duties as determined by the Chief's Executive Council or any other Tł̓ch̓q law.

### **Consequential Repeal**

5. The *Tł̓ch̓q Language, Culture and Communication Law* is hereby repealed.

## **Coming into force**

- 6.** This law shall come into force on the date the Grand Chief signs this law.
