- (2) A director of Human Resources shall be appointed.
- (3) Subject to any direction provided by the Chief's Executive Council, the director shall
 - (a) ensure the language and culture programs and activities of the Tłıchǫ Government are carried out in a manner that enhances the Tłıchǫ language, culture and way of life;
 - (b) evaluate the language and culture programs including the role of the Cultural Coordinator; and
 - (c) perform other duties assigned by the Chief's Executive Council or any other Tłıchǫ law.

Regulations

- 4. The Assembly may enact regulations for the carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Law.
