TLĪCHŪ INVESTMENT CORPORATION LAW

Title

1. This law shall be cited as the *Tł̄chŭ Investment Corporation Law*.

Definitions

2. In this Law,

“Assembly” has the same meaning as in the Tł̄chŭ Constitution.

“Chief’s Executive Council” has the same meaning as in the Tł̄chŭ Constitution.

“department” means a department of the Tł̄chŭ Government.

“director” means the director of the Investment Corporation.

“Tł̄chŭ Government” means the Tł̄chŭ Government and its institutions as defined in the Tł̄chŭ Constitution.

Establish Corporation

3. There is hereby established a department to be known as the Tł̄chŭ Investment Corporation.
4. A director of the Investment Corporation shall be appointed.

Chief’s Executive Council

5. The Chief’s Executive Council shall be responsible for the management and protection of all Tł̄chŭ Government interests in any

corporation, joint venture, society, proprietorship, limited partnership or other entity.

6. The Chief's Executive Council may authorize the director to take all necessary steps to ensure the good administration of the Tłchq Government's interests referred to in section 5.

7. Prior to July 31 2006, the Chief's Executive Council will recommend to the Assembly a law to set out the structure and organization of the Tłchq Investment Corporation and the governance of all the interests referred to in section 5.

Regulations

8. The Assembly may enact regulations for the carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Law.
