The successful candidate will possess a Master's Degree or PhD in any field, and have experience in policy analysis, project management, administration, and communications. Equivalent qualifications will be considered. The successful candidate will be a highly organized, excellent communicator and team builder and leader, who embraces innovation and thrives in a busy and independent environment, and is available to travel in the NWT and nationally.
