**Notice:** All people selected for the trip will need to participant in one Pre-Trip planning workshops in each of the communities, on their own time (evening/weekend) to get to know each other, as well as develop a meal plan, grocery listing, look at the route, talk about safety and much more.

Trips will be different lengths depending on community departure. Arrival in **Behchokò** is **Sunday**, **August 10**<sup>th</sup>.

**Notice:** There will be no alcohol or drugs allowed on the journey. Use of drugs and alcohol in this program, is both unsafe and disrespectful. Anyone caught bringing or using drugs or alcohol on the trip, will be removed from the trip as soon as possible, pay adjusted accordingly, and possibly banned from future Tłycho Government meetings and On The Land Programming.

### Due to our program budget, we can only select a limited number of paddlers from each community. This year, we are able to send the following:

- Behchokỳ: 10 canoes (60 people)
- Whatì: 5 canoes (30 people)
- Gamètì: 3 canoe (18 people)
- Wekweètì: 3 canoes (18 people)
- Yellowknife: 2 canoes (12 people)
