Employment and Training with the Giant Mine Remediation Project!

The Giant Mine Remediation Project (GMRP) has started and contractors might call you about hiring qualified Indigenous candidates to fulfill their Indigenous training and employment commitments. Contractors may need help in two main areas:

- 1. **Trainees or recent graduates** from career development programs your organization sponsors / delivers.
- 2. **Employment Agency services** like having a list of individuals seeking work and can be contacted by contractors who have positions to fill.

AR1 Freeze Program Work Package

Parsons as the Main Construction Manager for the Giant Mine Remediation Project (GMRP) expects to issue a contract for the AR1 Freeze Program that includes at least this work:

- Grubbing of stumps and roots followed by excavation of contaminated soils from the footprint of the AR1 Freeze Pad. This
 includes loading, hauling, and transportation of cleared/grubbed material, potential buried debris and contaminated soils to
 MCM approved locations on site.
- 2. Dewatering of ponded contaminated soil area, collecting contact water and disposing at the MCM approved location.
- 3. Rock excavation, utilizing drill and blast methods, to provide a flat subsurface for the future installation and maintenance of the freeze pipes by another contractor.
- 4. Load, haul, and stockpile the waste rock at the MCM approved locations on site for future processing by others.
- 5. Collection and containment of drainage (contact) water for sampling and analyses and transport for disposal in the MCM approved location (sampling and analyses will be done by other subcontractors).
- 6. Using granular material furnished by MCM, construct a working pad.
- 7. Supply and placement of geotextile.

The following labourers are needed to complete the work described above for the AR1 Freeze Program. If contractors don't have enough staff, they might contact you to hire qualified individuals for the jobs shown below.
