Behchokò Travel Requirements

COVID-19 INFORMATION

TRAVELLER STATUS	WHAT IS NEEDED AT CHECKSTOP	HOW TO GET DOCUMENTATION
 Fully vaccinated resident without known exposure to COVID-19	 Vaccination record or give consent to verify or provide proof of vaccination document	 Proof of immunization – contact the public health location where you were vaccinated
 Not fully vaccinated resident without known exposure to COVID-19	 Assessment card if you had a negative COVID-19 test (valid for 72 hours)	 Call the health centre for a COVID-19 test to get an assessment card. Please plan ahead of time.
 Resident who has been positive for COVID-19 prior to the last 180 days and recovered	 Letter from OCPHO	 Email to request an exemption letter ocpho@gov.nt.ca or contact Protect NWT: call 811 or email protectnwt@gov.nt.ca
 Residents travelling for medical appointments	 Provide a note for approved medical travel	 Ask for a note to undergo travel from your health care provider
 Unvaccinated Behchokò Residents returning to the community	 Assessment card if you had a negative COVID-19 test (valid for 72 hours)	 Call the health centre for a COVID-19 test to get an assessment card. Please plan ahead of time.
 Unvaccinated non-residents of Behchokò leaving the community who reside in another community	 Assessment card if you had a negative COVID-19 test (valid for 72 hours)	 Call a health centre for a COVID-19 test to get an assessment card prior to travel. Please plan ahead of time.



The following are not permitted to leave isolation nor self-isolation location for the purpose of travelling out of the community boundaries of Behchokò:

- Anyone who has COVID-19.
- Contacts of a person who has COVID-19.
- Those who live with someone who has COVID-19.
- Those who have been told to self-isolate or isolate by a healthcare provider.
- Those with symptoms of COVID-19 who are awaiting assessment.
