Thicho Community Government Election Chief and Council Election Notice

Notice is given to the voters of Gameti those nominations for Chief and Council Open on Monday, **May 1, 2017** and close on Monday, **May 15, 2017 at 3:00 pm** for the general election to be held on **June 12, 2017**.

The Community Government of Gameti has a total of six (6) Councilors positions to fill. Half the positions of councilor **MUST** be filled by eligible candidates who are Tlicho Citizens and the remaining positions **MAY** be filled by any eligible candidate.


The Community Government of Gameti has one (1) position as Chief to fill and can **ONLY** be filled by a Tlicho Citizen.

Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer or Deputy Returning Officer personally or to the office of the Returning Officer at:

ELIGIBILITY OF CHIEF

- Is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- Must be a Tlicho Citizen;
- Has attained the age of 18 years of election day;
- Has resided in the community of Gameti for the last 6 months preceding election day;
- Has resided in Mqwhi Gogha De Niitlee for 2 years preceding election day; and
- Is not subject to any of disqualifications set out in section 14 of the Tlicho Community Government Act.

Eligibility of Councilor

- Is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- May be a Tlicho Citizen (half of Council positions must be filled by Tlicho Citizens, the remaining Council positions may be filled by eligible candidates);
- Has attained the age of 18 years on election day;
- Has resided in the Community of Gameti for the last 6 months preceding election day;
- Has resided Mqwhi Gogha De Njtiee for 2 years preceding election day; and
- Is not subject to any of the disqualifications set out in section 14 of the Tlicho Community Government Act.
