

# **PURPOSE**

Shehtah Nabors LP is pleased to offer Dene and their descendents the opportunity to be granted a scholarship award towards post secondary education.

## **VALUE**

Shehtah Nabors LP will award a total of **eight (8) scholarships** per school year. The awards will be valued at **Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500)** each.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Shehtah Nabors welcomes all Dene and their descendents to apply for the scholarship.

Open to members of the following:

- Akaitcho Territory Government
- Dehcho First Nations
- Gwich'in Tribal Council
- Sahtu Dene Council
- Tlicho Government

Scholarships will be awarded only to those entering or continuing post-secondary or vocational programs as full-time students (three or more classes per semester).

- <u>Undergraduate Degree</u> students who have completed at least one full-time year of undergraduate degree program.
- College Technical Diploma or Certificate students who have completed at least one full-time year of college or technical institution diploma or certificate program.
- <u>Post-Secondary Entrance</u> students who have recently graduated from high school and are enrolled in a post-secondary program at a university, college or technical institution.
- Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of prior year grades. Students who are applying must have grades above 75%.

### **HOW IT WORKS?**

June:

The program is communicated through various media.

July 15:

Deadline for applicants to submit the following:

- Completed attached application form
- Prior year grades (transcript)
- Proof of registration (receipt of payment)
- Letter stating your goals

July 15 - 30:

Shehtah Nabors Scholarship Committee reviews the applicants.

July 30:

Scholarships will be awarded and students will be notified of the

results.

February:

Recipients from the prior year will be provided with a T4A for

taxation purposes.

# APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND RESTRICTIONS:

Applications and supporting materials must be received at the Shehtah Nabors office by July 15, 2014 by 5:00 pm MST. Late applications will not be accepted. Scholarships will be awarded only to those seeking degrees from an accredited colleges, universities or technical schools. No application will be processed without a copy of the most recent transcript of high school, college or university grades. Applicants must include the name of the college, university or school they plan to attend and provide a receipt of confirmation of student's enrollment at an institution.
