OUTLINE OF POSITION:

The Tłichq Jmbè Team Leader is responsible for learning, organizing, leading, participating in and evaluating activities including: Tłichq culture and traditional lifestyle activities, Safety certificate program and Life skills programs and for providing support and leadership to a small group throughout the summer both on the land and in the community, under the supervision of Program managers, Elders and Tłichq Government staff. Group Leaders are expected to set an example through their behavior by contributing to the community in a positive and meaningful way.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

The Jmbè Program Team Leaders are expected to have the following skills and attitudes:

- Be proud of their Tłichq heritage
- Have strong interest in learning, preserving and promoting more of their Tłichq culture, heritage, language and traditional skills
- Ability to lead small groups
- Have knowledge or interest in group dynamics, goals setting and team building
- Have very good interpersonal, verbal communications, motivation, team building, organizational and administrative skills
- Enjoy working outdoors, spending time on the land and on the water
- Be able to work with Tłichq community members, particularly elders
- Have the ability to work independently and follow directions
- Be knowledgeable of risk management
- Demonstrate good judgment in terms of safety issues and problem-solving skills
- Tłichq Yati skills are an asset

- Be currently enrolled, planning to return or start attending post-secondary school in the fall
