The 18th Tłycho Annual Gathering is the highest institution of the Tłicho Government, it is a forum for Tłicho citizens to be involved in the social, political and cultural activities of the Ticho. It also provides the opportunity for The citizens to ask questions, make recommendations and provide policy direction to the Tłıcho Assembly.

I encourage you to attend the meetings, and the cultural and social events that take place during the 18th Tłycho Annual Gathering. Please take time to speak to leadership, ask questions and make recommendations. I look forward to speaking and visiting with you and your family during the 18th Tłycho Annual Gathering. Excerpts from the Tłicho Constitution

7.0 The Annual Gathering

7.1 The Tłycho Assembly shall convene an Annual Gathering of the Tłycho, which shall be held on a rotation basis in each Tircho community. The purpose of the Annual Gathering is to bring people together to share in the social, political and cultural activities of the Tlicho. Among other things, the following matters shall be attended to at the Annual Gathering:

- a) an open forum shall be held where Tłicho citizens may ask questions, make recommendations and provide broad policy directions to the Ticho Assembly;
- b) nominations for the Grand Chief shall be announced in the year of
- c) annual reports including financial reports on the activities of the Tłycho Government and its institutions shall be presented;
- d) debate, consideration an approval of proposed amendments to the Ticho Agreement or to this Constitution; and
- e) consider approval of motions from the Tłycho Assembly

8.0 The Tłıcho Assembly

8.1 The Tłycho Assembly has the responsibility and authority to implement the Tłicho Agreement and to protect and ensure good government of the Tłicho Government and its rights, titles and interests. The Tłycho Assembly may enact Tłycho laws for these purposes and in relation to all matters for which the Tłycho Government has authority pursuant to the Tłycho inherent right of selfgovernment and the Tłicho Agreement.

8.2 The Tłycho Assembly shall be formed on the principle of equal representation from each Tłicho community and shall include the following:

- (a) the Grand Chief:

- (c) at least two (2) councillors from each Tłicho community




